Acid Rain Lab – Easy Peasy All-in-One High School According to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), acid rain consists of precipitation with a pH value of less than about 5.3 due to excess sulfur dioxide (SO₂) and nitrogen oxides (NO_x) released by both natural sources -- volcanoes and decaying vegetation -- and man-made sources -- industries (i.e. electrical power generation) and transportation that require the combustion of fossil fuels. from burning coal and oil then it is mixed with oxygen to create SO_2 (sulfur dioxide) which is then mixed with water vapor to get to H_2SO_4 (sulfuric acid) and comes down as acid rain. Normal rain usually has a pH between 5.0 to 5.5. Acid rain has a pH of 4.0 to 4.2. Acid Rain Lab - Caroline's Lab Reports This experiment showed the damaging effects of acid rain on grass growth. The EPA reported that acid rain can cause, "slowed growth of some forests...Leaves and needles turn brown and fall off when they should be green and healthy." trees at high elevations and many sensitive forest soils.
